Jodhpur School of Public Health (JSPH) is one of the foremost public health schools in the South Asian region offering post graduate education, training and research in public health. It functions as Public Health Department at Maulana Azad University and began its journey in 2008 as the first school to offer public health degree programme in Jodhpur and Rajasthan, India.

Programme

MPH is a two years programme and offers students an integrative, interdisciplinary strategy to address population and health care needs through instruction, research and service.

The MPH Degree is a demanding, interdisciplinary programme emphasizing active, student-directed learning, problem solving and the acquisition of skills essential to the practice of public health.

The curriculum is organized around five core disciplines: Bio Medical aspects of health, epidemiology, social and

Eligibility: Applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree in any field with 50 per cent marks and must have at least two years' experience in public health. The candidates must demonstrate proficiency in both oral and written English.

Selection procedure: Selection is based on the merit and educational qualification as well as the work experience in the healthcare field

Scanned copy of the degree and last three year's mark sheets and a copy of passport for international applicants should be sent before the last date mentioned in the form.
